DIALED IN outrun while saving ground, eased out and began advancing off the rail around the far turn, angled to the outside for the stretch run, then responded to pressure and rallied to be just in the final yards. SHACKLEFORD moved to gain a slim advantage racing into the first turn, set the pace off the rail, eased to the inside entering the far turn, opened a clear lead in early stretch, drifted out a bit under left-handed pressure inside the eighth pole, was straightened away to continue making the pace to deep stretch, then just failed to last. TO HONOR AND SERVE prompted the pace along the rail, was eased back and outside SHACKLEFORD entering the far turn, continued to try that rival into the stretch, then tired. FLASHPOINT taken in hand to stalk the pace three wide into the stretch, gave way. SOLDAT reserved in striking position along the rail, had no response when asked midway of the far turn and faltered in the drive. ARCH TRAVELER tracked the leaders three wide into the far turn, then faded. STAY THIRSTY taken in hand to save ground, was through after a half mile. BOWMAN'S CAUSEWAY was done early and eased in the stretch run.
